The significance of this is that we know that a Daughter, Jane, was baptised in March 1809 at Chichester and the Goodwood racecourse is but a few miles from Chichester. This now gives us the regiment Levi was in and sometime in the near future I shall be examining the Description Books for the period at Kew.

Furthermore the marriage of [Levi and Sarah McGilchrist](#) has now been found at Cambridge via the latest IGI updates. Looks like a trip to Cambridge also in the Summer.
